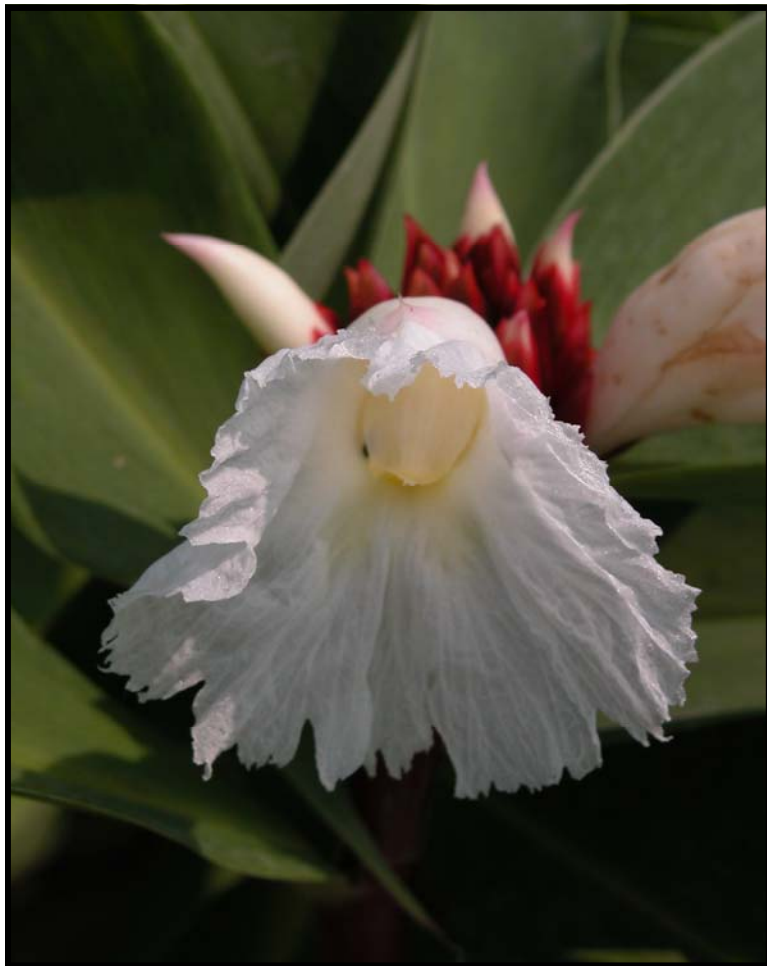


White Crepe Ginger

Costus speciosus



A dramatic 6'- 8' "shrub" with large, dark green leaves arranged on the stalk in a spiral. Unusual flowers form in late summer and early fall – red cone shaped bracts with 2" pure white crepe-like flowers emerging from each cone. After the flowers fade, the attractive red cone-shaped bracts remain. Goes dormant in winter.
